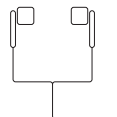

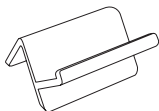

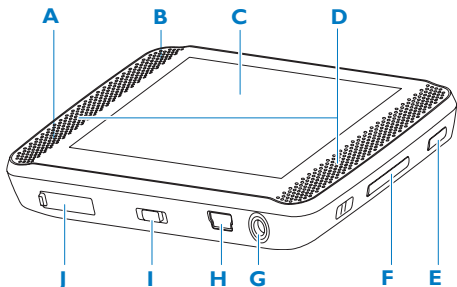


Computer

You need a computer with the following minimum requirements:

- Pentium III 800 MHz processor or higher
- 128 MB RAM
- 500 MB hard disk space
- Internet connection
- Windows® Internet Explorer 6.0 or later
- USB Port

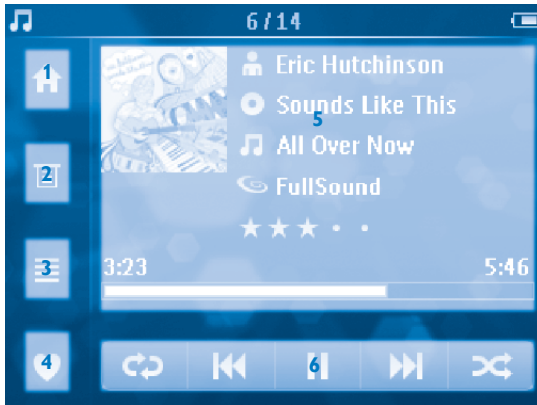


A	RESET	press: reset SA065

Overview of the main touchscreen features



The touchscreen allows navigation and control through direct touch (tap) on the relevant screen area. There are many application-specific features and activities. This is an overview of the basic features.

Connect SA065 to a computer

- 1 Connect the USB plug of the supplied USB cable to a spare USB port on your computer.
- 2 Connect the small USB plug of the USB cable to the small USB jack on SA065.
- 3 Turn on your computer.
 - > SA065 charges.



Note

- For first-time use, allow SA065 to charge for 3 hours.
- The charging animation stops and the  icon is displayed when the charging process is completed.

Connect to install software

- 1 Connect the mini USB plug of the supplied cable to SA065.
- 2 Connect the standard USB plug of the supplied cable to your computer.
> A pop-up window appears on the computer.
- 3 From the pop-up window, select **Install Philips Device Manager**.
- 4 Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation of the **Philips Device Manager**.

If the pop-up window fails to appear on the computer...

- 1 Select **My Computer** (WindowsXP® / Windows2000®) / **Computer** (WindowsVista®).
- 2 Right click on **Philips GoGear SA065**.
- 3 Select **Install Philips Device Manager**.
- 4 Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation of the **Philips Device Manager**.

Cannot find the file on SA065?

- 1 Ensure that your computer is connected to the Internet.
- 2 Select **My Computer** (WindowsXP® / Windows2000®) / **Computer** (WindowsVista®).
- 3 Right click on **Philips GoGear SA065**.
- 4 Select **Install Philips Device Manager**.
- 5 Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation of the **Philips Device Manager**.

Install software

SA065 comes with the following software:

- **Philips Device Manager** (helps you get firmware updates for SA065)

Important

- You can install the software while charging SA065 for the first time.

Turn SA065 on and off

1 To toggle between modes on and off, slide and hold ⓘ for approximately 4 seconds.

SA065 has a lock switch to prevent accidental operation.

1 To lock the buttons when you play, move the slider to position 🔒.

> All buttons except the volume keys are locked and the display shows a lock icon.

2 To unlock the buttons again, move the slider to the center position.

Listen to music

- 1 From the main menu, tap  to enter music mode.
- 2 Navigate the sub-menus to select your music.
- 3 Tap music track to highlight.
- 4 Tap music track again to play.
 - Tap  to pause play.
 - Tap  to resume play.
 - To exit and return to the main menu, press **HOME** or tap .

Play videos

- 1 From the main menu, tap  to enter video mode.
- 2 Navigate the sub-menus to select your video.
- 3 Tap video to highlight.
- 4 Tap video track again to play.
 - Tap  to pause play.
 - Tap  to resume play.
 - To exit and return to the main menu, press **HOME** or tap .

During video play, navigate as follows:

- 1 Tap  or  to skip to next / previous video.
- 2 Tap and hold  or  to scan current video forward / backward.
 - Tap  to resume play.

Access CMMB subscription channels

You can

- watch CMMB* TV channels
- listen to CMMB* audio channels

- 1 From the main menu, tap  to enter CMMB channels.
> SA065 reminds you not watch the screen while driving.
- 2 Extend the built-in telescopic antenna and align for best reception.
- 3 Tap ▲ or ▼ to select a service from the list.
- 4 SA065 scans the frequencies for CMMB signals and displays all available channels.
- 5 Tap on a channel to watch or listen.
 - To exit and return to the main menu, press **HOME** or tap .

Record CMMB audio

You can record the audio of CMMB* channels on SA065:

- 1 From the main menu, tap  to enter CMMB channels.
> SA065 reminds you not watch the screen while driving.
- 2 Extend the built-in telescopic antenna and align for best reception.
- 3 Tap  or  to select a service from the list.
- 4 SA065 scans the frequencies for CMMB signals and displays all available channels.
- 5 Tap on a channel.
- 6 Tap  to start recording the audio of the channel.
 - Tap  to pause recording.
 - Tap  (red dot) to resume recording.
- 7 Tap to save or delete.
 - > Tap to confirm.
 - > SA065 resumes CMMB service.
 - To exit and return to the main menu, press **HOME** or tap .

CMMB urgent messages

The CMMB* service includes urgent messages.

Incoming messages are indicated with the following icon at the top of the screen: 

- 1 Tap **Emergency news** to see the list of news messages.
> Messages are displayed as follows: * = urgent message, n = new message, i = message.
- 2 Tap on a message to open it.
 - Tap  or  to scroll up or down.
 - Tap  to see the options menu.
 - Select the option to delete the message.
- 3 Tap **Close** to close window.
> The current CMMB broadcast continues after the message is closed.

CMMB emergency news and urgent messages

The CMMB* services include emergency news.

Emergency news interrupt the current broadcast with a pop up window.

Upon incoming emergency news...

1 Tap **More** to read more (if message exceeds single screen size).

- Tap  to see the options menu.
- Select the option to delete the message.

2 Tap **Close** to close window.

> *The current CMMB broadcast continues after the message is closed.*

Listen to FM radio

SA065 automatically searches for FM radio stations, then saves the first 20 strongest frequencies under the available presets.

- 1 From the main menu, tap  to enter radio mode.
 - > SA065 starts to play the last played preset.
 - Tap to select any of the preset numbers in the list.
 - To exit and return to the main menu, press **HOME** or tap .

Settings

This is how you customize SA065:

- 1 From the main menu, tap  to enter settings mode.
- 2 Tap  or  to navigate in a list.
 - Tap  to enter sub menu (when available).
- 3 Tap to confirm a selection and go to the next level (when available).
 - To exit and return to the main menu, press **HOME** or tap .

Manually verify / update firmware

- 1 Ensure that your computer is connected to the Internet.
- 2 Connect SA065 to the computer (see section **Connect SA065 to a computer** for instructions).
- 3 On your computer, click **Start > Programs > Philips Digital Audio Player > SA065 Device Manager** to launch **Philips Device Manager**.
- 4 Click **Update**.
 - > **Philips GoGear SA065 Device Manager** checks for updates and installs new firmware from the Internet, if available.
- 5 When the display shows **Update completed**, click **OK**.
- 6 Disconnect SA065 from the computer.
 - > The display of SA065 shows **Updating firmware**.
 - > SA065 restarts after the firmware is updated and is ready for use again.
